

OPERATION POSITIVE ATTITUDE



1. When you come to the Lodge, come with the attitude “I’m here to have a good time.”
2. If you come to complain, one of two things will happen:
 - a. You will be asked to chair a committee or fix or solve the problem
 - OR
 - b. You will be told to check your attitude at the door.
3. Remember, most everyone here is a volunteer so don’t yell at them or you can replace them!
4. Remember, everyone is here to have a good time, so if you have a negative attitude, leave it at the front door.
5. Remember, no one person is any better than anyone else in the Lodge.
6. Remember, the Lodge Officers and the House Committee are here to make the Lodge a better place, so respect them for the difficult job they have committed to do. Work with them, not against them!
7. Remember, every Lodge member deserves respect. If you want to gossip or bad mouth, take it elsewhere.
8. Remember, the Lodge is a team and there is no “I” in team. We need to all work together to make the Lodge work.
9. Remember, volunteering is what makes the Lodge work. If you or no one else volunteers, nothing will get done, i.e. Steak Fries and other functions.
10. Remember, this is a good Lodge and with a positive attitude we can make it even better.
